Bray Park SHS Music scholarship is designed to provide recognition to a Year 6 student who has demonstrated excellence in their music endeavours. The scholarship will provide support for the student to continue their music studies through the Bray Park Co-Curricular Music Program. Bray Park SHS provides many opportunities for all of our students to extend their academic, sporting or cultural talents through a wide range of enrichment activities and programs. We expect active citizenship of our scholarship recipients within and beyond our school community, in line with our values of Trust, Respect, Integrity, Commitment and Compassion.

The application process will involve submitting the attached application form along with relevant support documentation, as well as completing an audition with Bray Park SHS Music staff.

Information for Auditions:

- You will be required to play one piece on your chosen instrument. The chosen piece should indicate your level of ability (don't choose a piece that is too easy or hard).
- Warm up rooms will be available 10 minutes prior to your audition time.
- Auditions will take approximately 5 minutes in length with some general questions on past musical experience and commitment.
