Celebration of student work over the semester. Moreton Bay City Mayor's Telstra Youth Innovation Awards – a record 8 teams participating. 5 Bray teams made the finals held on Thursday 18 June. SUMO Robotics – Mrs Deb Benson took students to the Regional Robotics Finals last Saturday. Kokoda Challenge – 20 students and 5 staff took on the gruelling 30 km course through D'Aguilar National Park on Saturday. Rasing money for the Kokoda Youth Foundation and supported by kind sponsors SNAP Fitness Warner. Year 12 ATAR Mentoring – Underway with all students assigned a mentor to guide our year 12s - plan for the rest of year and their next steps. Year 11 Academic Conferencing – 22nd July (Week 3) – Students only attend for their conference. Leadership Camp – Held at Emu Gully on the first three days after the winter break. 32 year 11 students attending. Nationally Consistent Collection of Data (NCCD)- Moderation of data underway- students with disability requiring additional supports sitting at around 30% of total enrolments. Athletics Carnival – Full school carnival held Friday 26 June. Pre-carnival events held in days prior. Volleyball News – Four teams competed at the Volleyball Queensland Intermediate Schools Cup at Gold Coast and the Year 10 Boys placed third. Our Opens play in August at Gold Coast. Basketball News – Three teams performed very well in the Brisbane Outer Schools League Competition this term. Futsal News – Open Boys placed third in Queensland at the VETO 2026 Finals. 2027 Year 9, 10, 11 Parent Information Evening – Tuesday 21 July onsite. Leading into SET Planning and Subject Selections. Student Led Conferencing next term to also support these decisions.

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	Student Led Conferencing/SET Plan Day – Proposed for 12 August (Ekka Wednesday) – Years 7, 8, 9 and 12 do SLCs, Year 10s do SET P, year 11s will be offsite for work placement/home study. This gives less disruption than running over several days. No regular classes for the day. Fanfare Competition – Our 5 ensembles competed in the district competition at Bray Park SHS. Awarded three golds and two silver awards. A great achievement. Awaiting now to see if we receive and invite to the Regional Finals. BPAC Dance Eisteddfod – incredible results for only our fifth year of Eisteddfods – several placings including a 1st and 2nd place for our Junior Troupe and several 4ths for our Seniors. Drama Performances – Year 11 and 12 Drama in Practice – Children’s Theatre on Wednesday 27 May - A full audience enjoyed the excellent performances; Actor’s Ensemble put on a great show “Cyberbile” on 11 June. Year 10s are on the 17 June. Under 8s Days – Our students did a great job supporting events at 8 local feeder schools by running activities.
