<p>Principal's Report presented by Peter Turner</p>	<p><u>Curriculum</u></p> <p>End Semester 1 Reports – were emailed out on last day of Term 2 – 25 June.</p> <p>Parent Teacher Interviews – With the Government's COVID-19 restrictions extended for SEQ unit Friday 23 July, we reviewed our Hall's capacity in light of the guidelines. Occupancy limits for our Hall, the inability of teachers/parents to socially distance in this setting, alternative rooming/timeslot constraints meant there was a need for parents and teachers to wear masks during the interviews and while moving around. To ensure the safety and comfort of parents and staff, the decision has been made to move to phone interviews only for PTI on Tuesday 20 July.
