This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard for years 7 & 9 to 100% in all three areas.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English, Maths & Science to beyond 88% in Years 7,8 & 9.
- Increase the percentage of students in the NAPLAN upper two bands (U2B) Year 7 30% & Year 9 25% in all three NAPLAN areas – Reading, Writing & Numeracy
- 100% students not meeting NMS will be provided with a Personal Support Plan
- Increase the % of students reaching 92% attendance and accessing enrichment activites.
- Ensure the percentage of Year 12 students attaining a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE) remains at 100% in 2021
- Next Step Data has above 90% of 2021/22 graduates engaged in further education, employment or training.
- School Opinion Survey for staff identifies that 90% of staff are conficent in embedding Indigenous perspectives.

Our initiatives include

- Continue to implement collaborative data inquiry processes (to build teachers' ability to interpret data, identify and scale-up effective teaching practices and differentiate more effectively).
- Focused implementation and professional learning for all staff in the teaching of reading using the 'Tactical Teaching of Writing' (TTW) strategy.
- Continue to implement a whole school approach for the identification and extension of high performing students across all learning areas including targeted approaches to support students achieving A & Bs & the U2B.
- Continue to implement effective processes for monitoring and mentoring of all senior students.
- Continued implementation of the New Art & Science of Teaching as the pedagogical framework including embedding the culture, climate, processes and protocols of classroom observation and feedback to support professional development and encourage reflective practice/action learning (Leadership Coaching and Watching Others Work WOW)
- Build pathways planning processes to ensure all students leave school with established options including support for students in Year 12.
- Continue to implement New Pedagogies for Deep Learning within Pedagogical Framework including teacher professional learning experiences both locally and globally
- Continue to implement engagement & enrichment key strategies through PBL & Global connections
